Corny's Bio

Across radio, television, and digital media, Corny Koehl has executive produced and programmed for some of the biggest names in media today including Oprah Winfrey, Gayle King, Suze Orman. She has EP'd well over 10,000 hours of original spoken word programming.

Prior to joining Agua Media and developing podcasts under her own umbrella, she helped develop and co-executive produced Super Soul Sunday, a weekly television program hosted by Oprah on the OWN Channel. Koehl was also instrumental in launching the "Oprah & Friends" 24/7 radio channel on XM Radio.

As Director of Program Development and Executive Producer, she helmed regular programs including, Oprah's Soul Series, The Gayle King Show, O the Oprah Magazine Show (hosted by Oprah and Gayle) and oversaw others including, The Dr. Oz (radio) Show, The Dr. Maya Angelou Show, and more. Koehl worked at ABC Radio Networks, where she served as the Director of Women's Programming and Executive Producer of the groundbreaking, Satellite Sisters. She began her career in radio at Premiere Radio Networks, where she was Executive Producer for The Dr. Laura Show and The Suze Orman Show.

She is the recipient of two Emmy Awards (four nominations), and two Gracie Awards for Outstanding Producer from the Alliance for Women in Media.
