Inaugural AWM Connects Program a Success

The incredibly impactful, inaugural AWM Connects mentorship program was held in December 2021. The program welcomed 14 mentees and 12 mentors with a live session for general discussion followed by one-on-one conversations. The participants enjoyed the opportunity to meet and discuss issues pertinent to women in media including career advancement advice, expanding experience opportunities and more. All the mentees were provided not only with mentorship but one free year of membership in AWM. These relationships have a long-lasting impact and shape the organization and media in general.

"Since graduating from film school I have felt the absence of a mentor who works in the industry and would guide me in my career path. We encourage Gracie Award submissions from all walks of media life, from creatives such as writers, broadcast journalists, and actors to technical categories, including producers and directors.
