After graduating from the University of Texas at Austin, Peterson worked at local TV stations in Toledo, Flint, Houston and Atlanta, as well as CNN and HLN. She has won 25 Emmy Awards, 2 National Murrows, a Cronkite, and 4 Gracie awards. Peterson is also a yoga instructor and mentors collegiate women as a sorority advisor for Alpha Phi.
